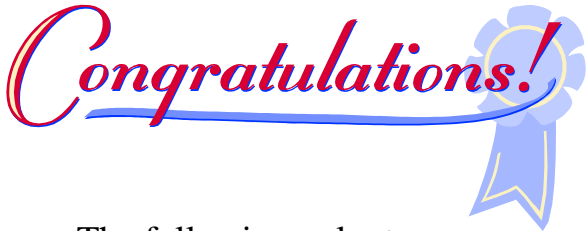

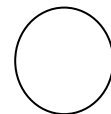
Tiered System:

0- 4,000 gallons	\$.95
4,001-6,000 gallons	\$1.20
6,001-8,000 gallons	\$1.45
8,001-12,000 gallons	\$1.70
12,001-20,000 gallons	\$1.95
20,001-up gallons	\$2.45

NEW GARBAGE RATE

Residential	\$23.60
Commercial	\$41.00
Spec. Assessment	\$44.60
