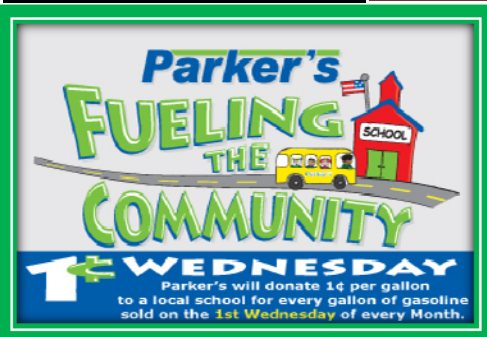
New Ordinance ~ Utility Reconnect Fee

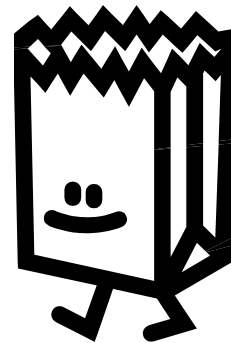
