List of Recyclable Materials

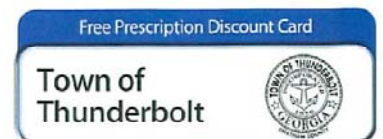
- **Aluminum and Steel** - Food and beverage containers. (Remove lids and rinse cans)
 - **Clear, Green and Brown Glass** - Food and beverage containers.
 - **Plastics** - No.1 thru 7 plastic food, beverage and product containers regardless of color. Example- soda and water bottles , milk jugs (Rinse and remove all lids)
 - **Newspaper, Magazines and Catalogs** - Glossy inserts may be included. May be collected in your recycle bin or place in a clear plastic bag set on top of your bin
 - **Fiberboard and paperboard** - examples are cereal and cracker boxes, etc.
 - **Corrugated Cardboard** - Flatten all boxes.

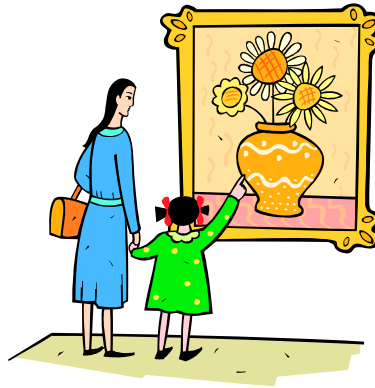


THUNDERBOLT POLICE DEPARTMENT
