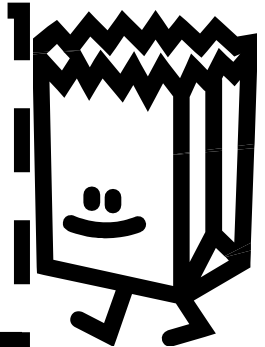
Message from the Mayor:

Remember: to put your Trash, Recycle, and Yard waste out the day before because Waste Pro will be picking up real early during the summer. Please place your Can 3ft from the Curb. Bag your yard waste. DO NOT put your yard waste in Recycle Bin. Remember NO Styrofoam (Cups, Plates or Food Trays) are recyclable. Also, No Tires, No Paint cans and No Light Bulbs

The only Time Waste Pro will be on Holiday Schedule is Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day. They will work on schedule for all other Thunderbolt Holidays. Please Remove Trash Cart and Recycle Bin from curbside once they have been emptied.

Dry Trash - Leaves and yard debris must be placed in the Paper Bags NOT in Plastic Bags per Town Ordinance.
