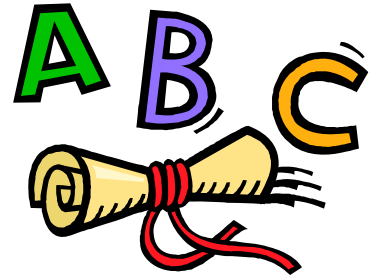

**The Thunderbolt Senior Center under new management!**

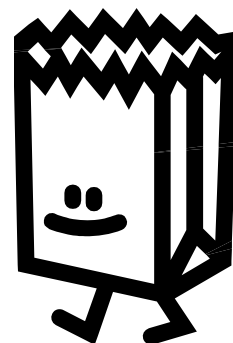
