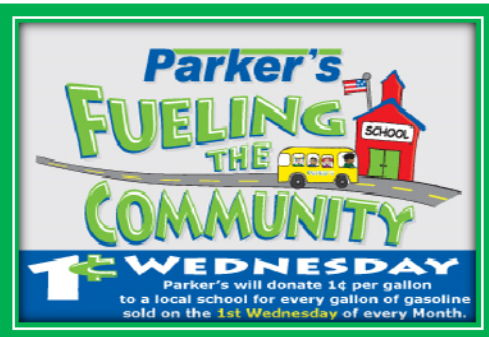

New Ordinances

§ 4-205(c) Utility Reconnect Fee
\$25 - 1st Reconnection Fee
\$75 - 2nd Reconnection Fee
\$125 - 3rd Reconnection Fee

Once fee is paid the Town will have 24 hours to reconnect service

Mayor and Council adopted City of Savannah's Sewage Collection & Disposal Ordinance addressing grease interceptors, installation and disposal of waste.

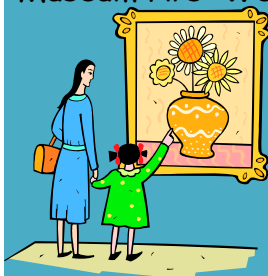

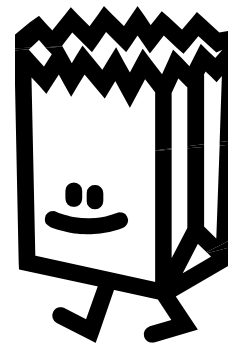
