

Guide for Residential Refuse Collection

The current rules for household refuse collection are as follows:

Household garbage pick-up is made twice weekly. If you do not know your designated day for garbage service, please contact Waste Pro Customer Service at 912.965.0777, or you can access the Town of Thunderbolt for your collection schedule at <http://thunderboltga.org>

All household garbage to be collected by Waste Pro personnel must be placed in the roll cart provided by WastePro. The Roll Cart is to be placed inside the curb, outside the drainage ditch line of the street,



near the front line of your premises, no earlier than 5:30 am and no later than 7:00 am, on your designated day of pick-up. The Roll Cart must be removed no later than 7:30 pm on your collection day.

No containers of any shape, size or form other than the roll-carts provided by the Town will be emptied and returned to the curb. Roll-carts, garbage bags or other disposable containers shall not be placed on the curb or ditch line at night or week-ends.

Containers of any shape and size other than Roll Carts provided by the Town are not permitted for household garbage on the curb at any time.

Compost / Yard Debris - Leaves and branch pickup is made once weekly. If you do not know your designated day, please contact Waste Pro. These items



must be containerized or put into clear plastic or paper bags of less than 50 lbs. or tied in bundles, also not to exceed 50 lbs. and 4 ft. in length per bundle. Building rubbish must be removed

and disposed by the contractor.

Bulky Items, Furniture, Appliances - Bulky items such as furniture and "white goods" (appliances, hot water heaters, etc...) which cannot be containerized or bundled are picked up ON A CALL BASIS ONLY. Call Waste Pro at 912.965.0777 or simply access the Town of Thunderbolt website and enter your own work order by clicking on the "service request" link. Work Orders placed by Thursday will be picked up on Saturday of the same week.

Town provided roll-carts and recycling bins shall be placed at least 2' apart at the curb due to separate vehicles collecting trash and recyclable.

Building material of any kind will not be accepted..

All garbage shall be drained and wrapped before placing into garbage containers.. Containers of refuse and garbage should be placed at the curb not later than 7:00am on the morning of the scheduled collection.

WHY RECYCLE ?

There are many good reasons for recycling. Each year, the per ton disposal costs increases. Each municipal taxpayer shares in paying for all disposal costs regardless of the generator. Thus, each ton diverted will have a greater savings potential. Conserving existing landfill life is the goal. The Town of Thunderbolt uses the landfill site known as Hickory

Hill Landfill located in Jasper County, SC. Other areas within the state also use this landfill. Costs for purchase of land and development of new landfill sites now exceed \$60 million dollars. Most communities cannot afford these types of costs and the monumental impact to the taxpayers.

Meeting the goals and objectives established within the Solid Waste Policy and Management Act of 1991 set goals of 30% diversion, with a 25% recycling rate for all waste going to sanitary landfills within the state. All recyclable materials collected within the Town of Thunderbolt are deposited in a fully accredited and licensed Material Recovery Facility.

REMEMBER

All residents within the Town Limits of Thunderbolt are encouraged to participate in the recycling program.

Residents of the Town of Thunderbolt who have questions about recycling or have not received their recycling bin and information please call 912.965.0777 for details.

All materials may be placed commingled in the one recycling bin. The bin should be placed at curbside no later than 7:00 am on your collection day.

LIST OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS

Aluminum and Steel - Food and beverage containers. (Please remove lids and rinse cans)

Clear, Green and Brown Glass - Food and beverage containers.

Plastics - No. 1 thru 7 plastic food and beverage containers regardless of color. example - soda and water bottles, milk jugs...please rinse and remove all lids.

Newspaper, Magazines and Catalogs - glossy inserts may be included. May be collected in your recycle bin or placed in a plastic bag set on top of your bin.

Fiberboard and paperboard - examples are cereal and cracker boxes, etc...

Corrugated Cardboard - flatten all boxes.

Holiday Schedule

Waste Pro observes Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day and New Year's Day. During the week of a holiday, service will be conducted on a one-day delay schedule. Example - If the holiday falls on a Monday, your garbage will be collected on Tuesday...if the holiday falls on Thursday, your garbage will be collected on Friday. Normal service schedules resume the next week following the holiday.

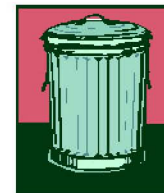
Your Pick-Up Day for Recycling is:
